



2016 SOUTH SEA SUZUKI INSHORE CLASSIC **RULES**

WHEN: 18th (Opening Function), 19th and 20th November 2016
WHERE: False Bay, See Attached Chart.
HOW: Rod and reel from a boat, kayak or Jet ski! Max 15Kg line!

ENTRANCE FEE: R400.00 per angler

PRIZES

Species section

- Only one fish per species, per angler will count per day.
- No Yellow Fin or Long Fin Tuna to count.
- No Sharks or Barbel to count.
- All fish weighed must be over 1 kilogram in weight to be eligible for prizes.
- Prizes will be allocated to the five **biggest** species caught.
- One fish can only win one prize

The committee's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Additional information:

Safety and area.

- **Valid Safety Certificate and Skippers ticket for all boats and a valid safety for all kayakers and jet ski's.**
- Launch at own risk from GBBAC
- All anglers to congregate at GBBAC.
- The fishing area is a 5-nauticle mile radius around Cape Point and Hang-Klip with a line joining the arc tangents. Rocky Banks included – 3-nauticle miles around the pinnacle.

Times

- Skippers briefing, Friday 18th November at GBBAC @ 19H00, compulsory!
(Either the skipper of the vessel or a representative needs to be at the briefing).
- Saturday 19th November 2016 (Day 1) - Launch At 05H00
- Sunday 20th November 2016 (Day 2) - Lines Up At 14h00
- Scale/Weigh In Times:
 - Saturday 19th November (17h00 To 19h00)
 - Sunday 20th November (07h00 To 08h00)
 - Sunday 20th November (14h00 To 16h00)
- Sunday 20th November (18h00 Prize Giving)

Weigh in.

- Weigh in to take place at **GBBAC only!**
- Queuing system will be in place for weigh-in so, important to let competition control know when you are in the harbour. Any late comers after weigh-in time has expired **will not be weighed.** If you are in the queue your fish will still be weighed!

Weather committee.

- Weather and Safety committee will consist of three boats.
- Three boats chosen at skippers briefing.
- There will be a control boat which will be nominated at the opening function!
- Weather committee decision will be made the evening before the fishing day by 19h00 pm.
- The weather call will be based on inshore (in the bay) conditions and not Cape Point.
- If a decision cannot be made the evening before a decision will be made on the day an hour before launch! The launch can be postponed until 8am.
- The committee's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
